



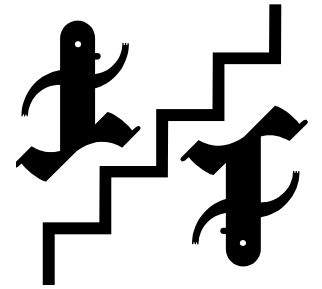

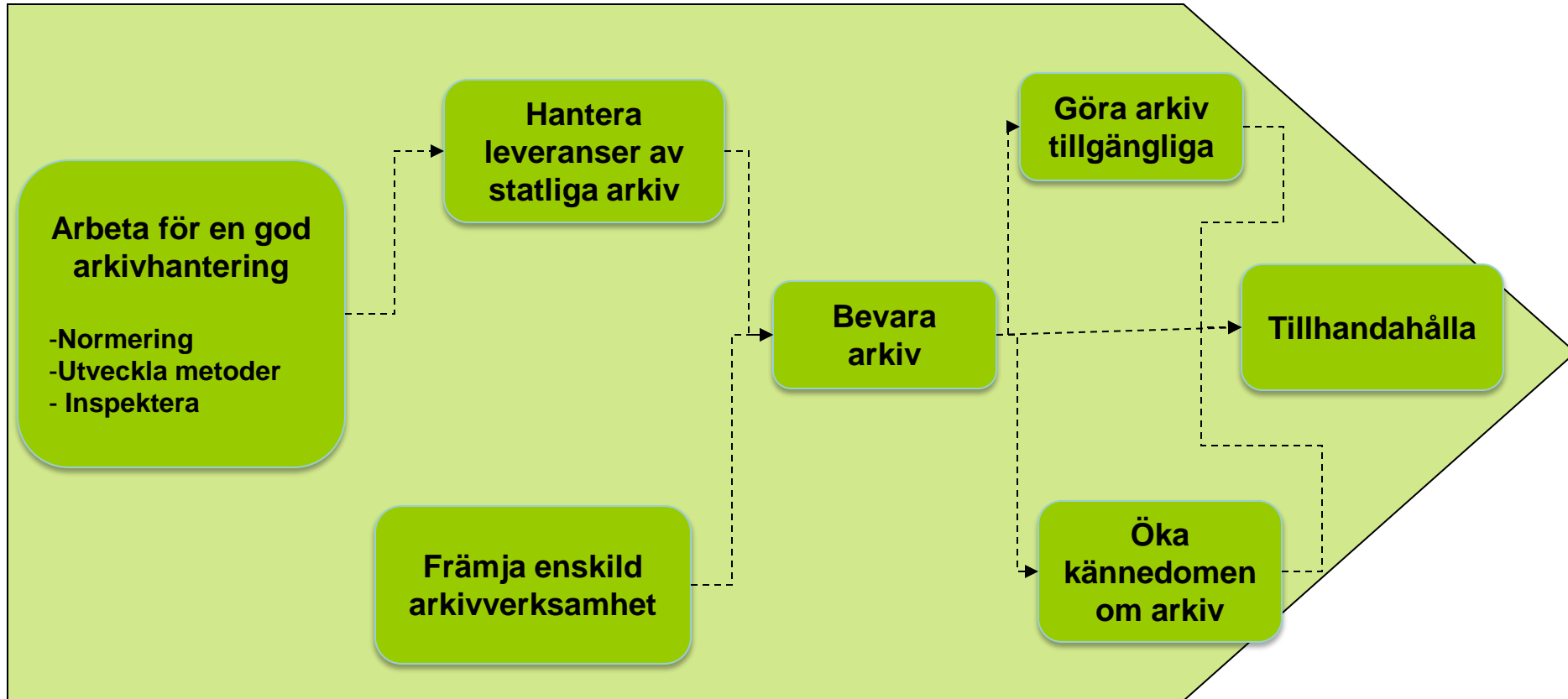


The Swedish National Archives

- One of the oldest public agencies in Sweden, founded in the 17th century
- The regional state archives were founded in the beginning of the 20th century and are located in Vadstena, Uppsala, Visby, Lund, Göteborg, Härnösand and Östersund
- In 2010 the Swedish NA and the regional state archives became one agency
- Since 2012 the Swedish NA is a process-oriented organization

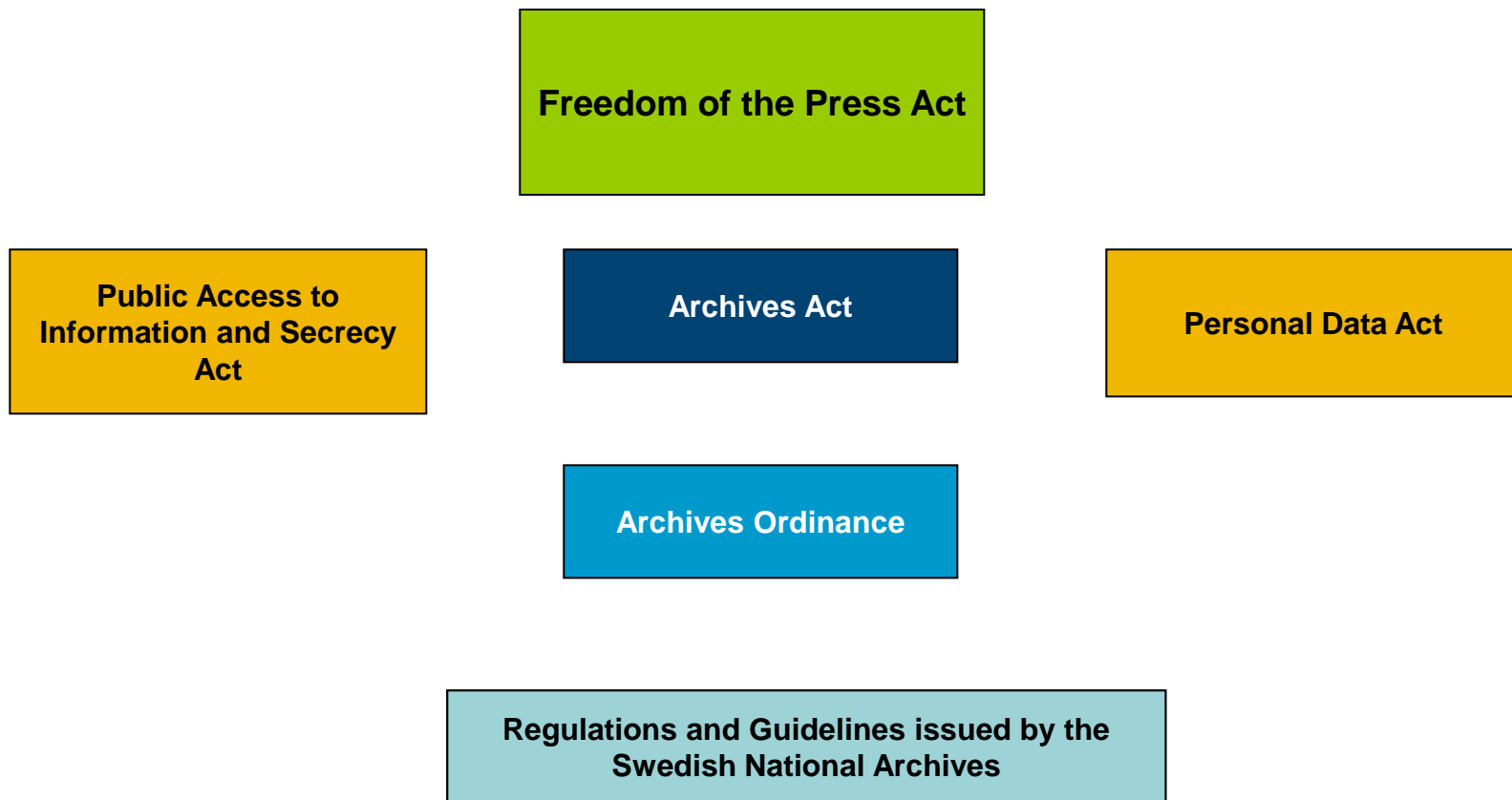

Structure of Legislation in the Archival Field



Freedom of the Press Act

- The right of access to official documents presupposes that documents are kept in their *original condition, text and context*
- E-documents are acknowledged
- Rules about preservation and deletion or other dispossessing of official documents shall be regulated in law

The Archives Act

- purposes

- Safeguard the right to access official documents
- Meet judicial and administrative needs
- Satisfy the needs of research
- Protect the national cultural heritage

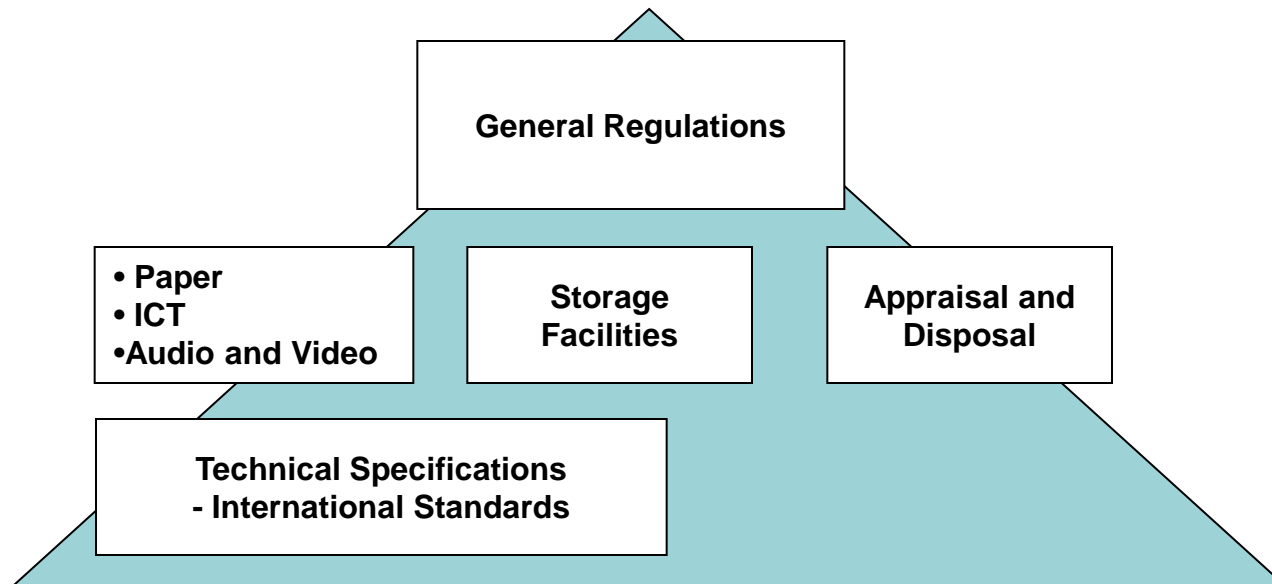


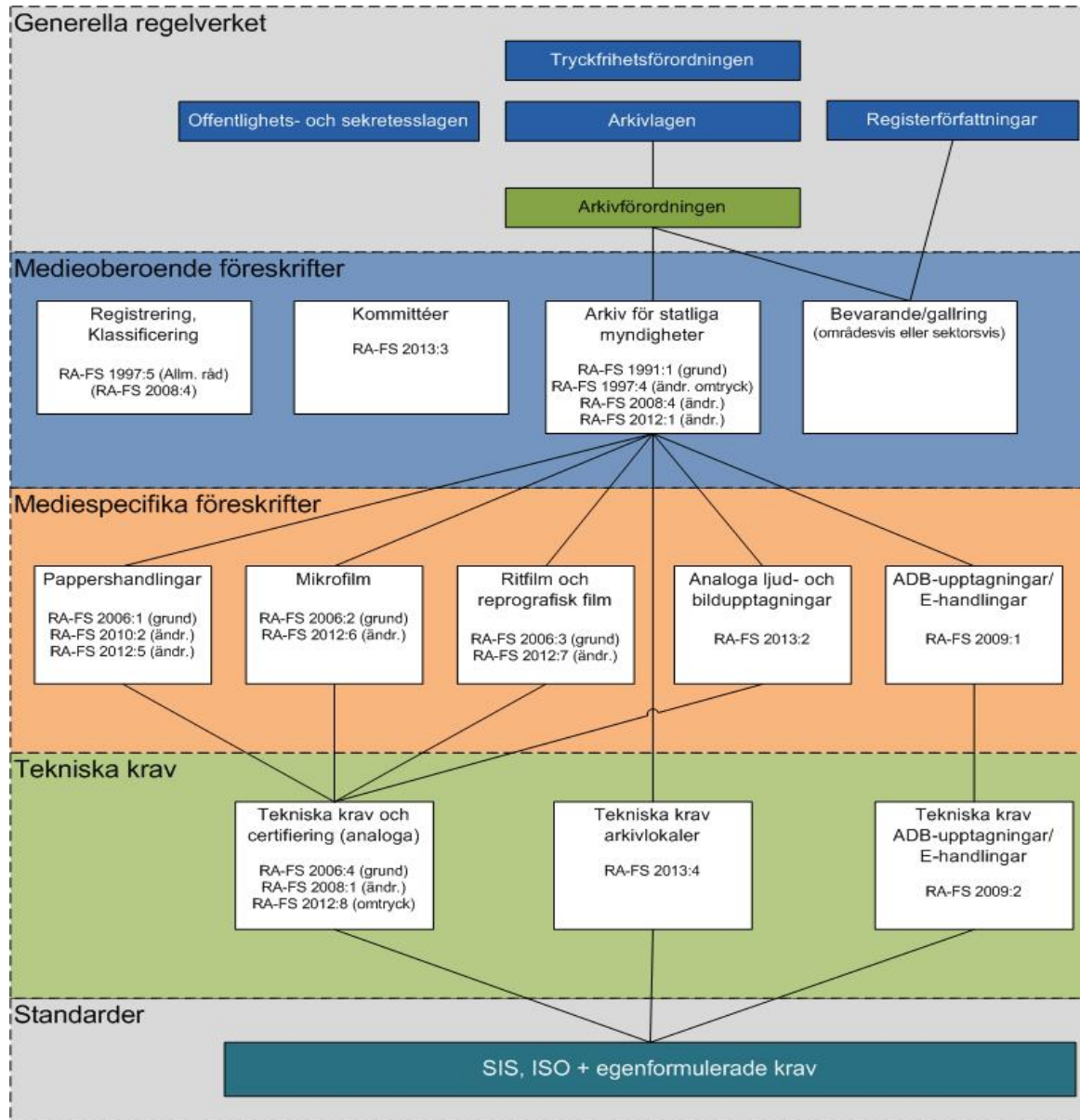
The Archives Act

- According to the Archives Act even after appraisal and selection of official documents the purposes of the act must be met
- Parliament and Government issues acts and ordinances concerning deletion of official documents (personal data protection) that sometimes overrides the Archival Act



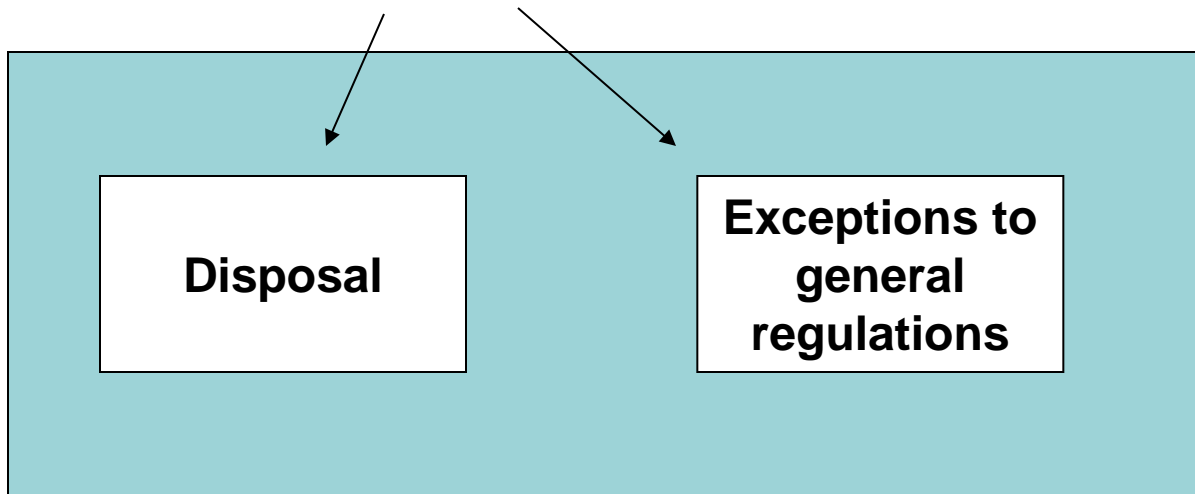
Swedish National Archives Regulations and Guidelines

- Specific regulations (RA-MS)





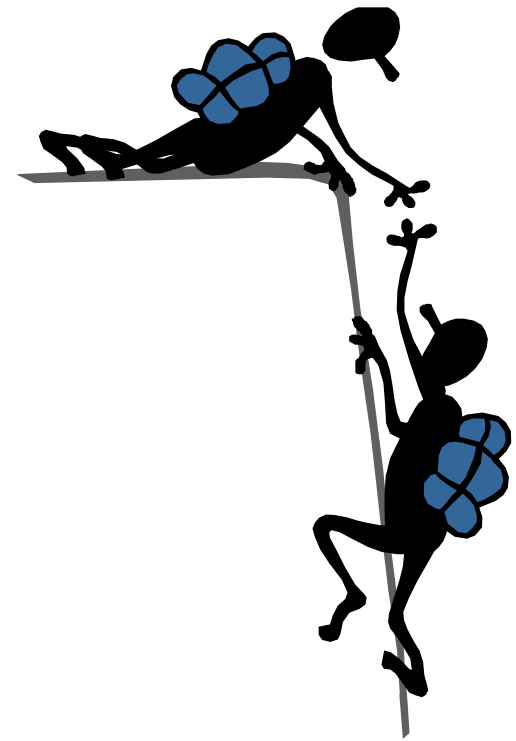
The National Archives in the Nordic countries

- We have different mandate
 - Different possibilities to govern the public sector
 - Different perspectives on appraisal, disposal and when archives should be transferred to the NA
- Common challenges
 - Digital preservation
 - eGovernment
 - (General Data Protection Regulation – the right to be forgotten and to erasure)

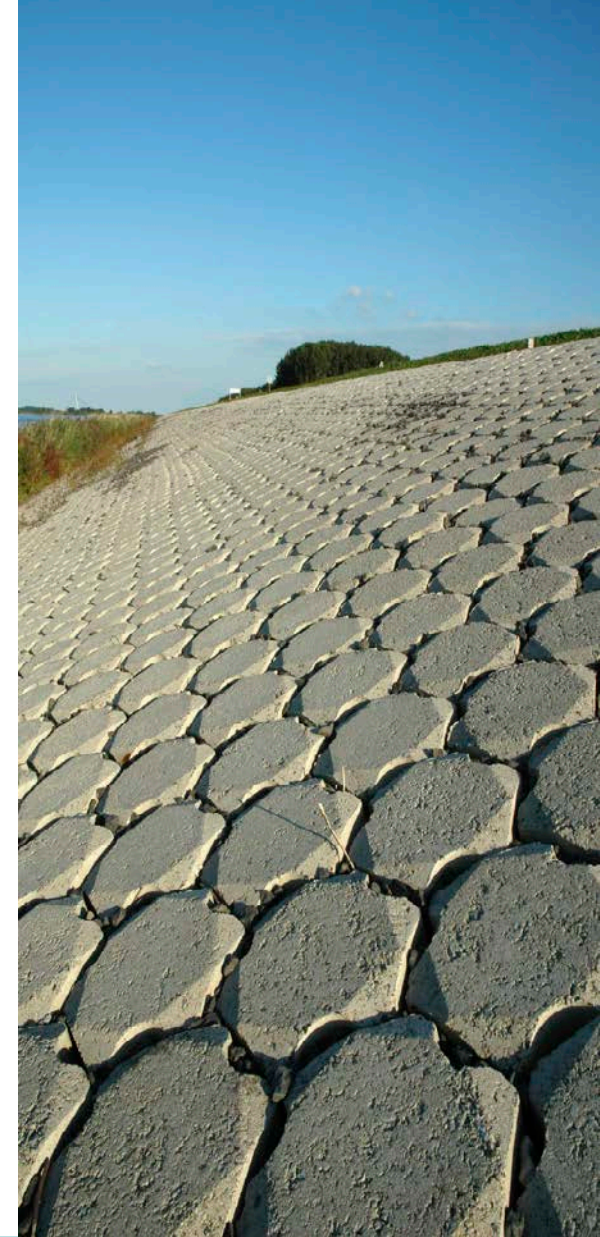
- hopes

- "Göra rätt från början"
 - Strategies and methods to create, manage and preserve e-documents
- "FGS"
 - "Guidelines" on e-archiving
- "The archive as a resource for eGovernment"

The future

- Public agencies

- More "regulations" on information management from other institutes than the Swedish public sector
 - What data/information to collect (processes and formats)
 - Several sectors create their own standards, often without taking to account the preservation aspects
- eGovernment needs
 - Inter-agency coordination
 - Interoperability
 - Strategies and methods for digital preservation



The future

- Riksarkivet

- A wider field?
 - The Swedish National Archive needs to cooperate with new partners and clients
- A different picture?
 - It has been suggested that the public agency Statens servicecenter will take care of "e-documents" from the public sector before they are transferred to the Swedish National Archive
 - Open Data
- "Less control, more cooperation"?
